He was called to give evidence in court, and was asked something like ‘Can you tell us in your own words what happened?’ To which the Aboriginal witness replied: ‘I plead guilty, eh?’ “(Eades 1994:248). What we see here is one of the main problems Aboriginal speakers have with called Standard English by not transferring the wanted answers. They somehow feel like being an observer in a process of law. In this paper, I will show the major problems of Aboriginal speakers with Standard English, with a closer look at courtroom English. This is a part of forensic linguistics. The language of law is very interesting for applied linguistics, because law is an important institution of a country’s constitution with a lot of influence on people’s every day life and it is packed with a lot of language problems, because even normal people have problems by reading law texts.
